Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals. **Trophies:** The Sverdlova Trophy and The Rosenfeld Cup

NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground
